Interested artists are asked to send a brief bio and flash drive of digital images in jpeg format with six to ten examples of artwork. Each example must be identified by title, size, and medium.

Artwork must meet the following criteria:

- Subject matter must be positive, uplifting or calming and suitable for viewing by all ages.
- Violent, graphic, or otherwise unsettling images are not appropriate in a healing environment.
- Nudity is not permitted.
- Religious symbols are not permitted.

The call for submission will begin May30 and will run through the close of business on July 30, 2021.
